

### Location

The conference will be held at The PGA National Resort and Spa, 400 Avenue of the Champions, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida 33418. There is a discounted hotel room rate of \$129. Valet parking is available for \$17/day. No resort fees. Reservations must be made on or before May 31, 2011 to secure a room at the special meeting rate. 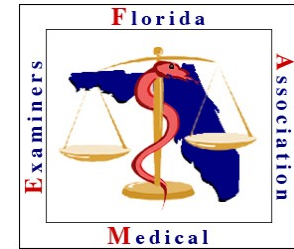
