Registration Fee

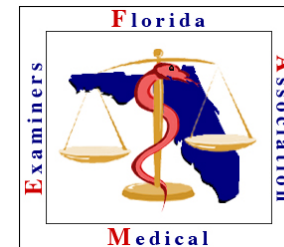

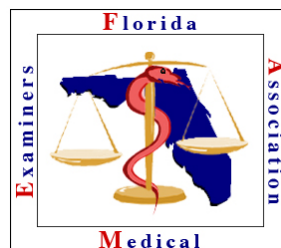
