### Location

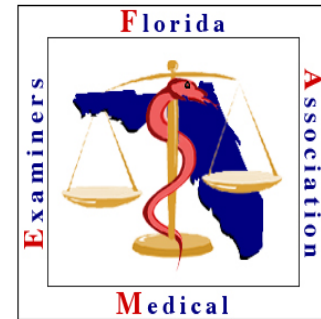
