

Location

The conference will be held at The Ritz-Carlton Orlando, Grande Lakes, 4012 Central Florida Parkway, Orlando, Florida 32837. There is a discounted hotel room rate of \$139. Valet parking is \$20.00/day. No resort fees. Reservations must be made on or before July 6, 2010 to secure a room at the special meeting rate. 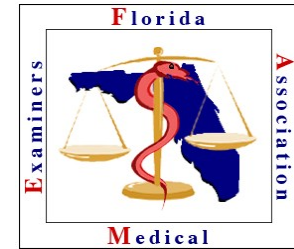
